HARVEST DRIVEN CIDER


Harvest driven cider is cider or perry that is primarily produced once a year from fruit that is picked and pressed close to their seasonally peak ripeness.

HARVEST DRIVEN CIDER IS GROWING



The median growth rate for harvest driven cider production from 2020 to 2021 was 30%

The harvest driven cider segment share grew by 1/3 from 2020 to 2021 from 1.8% to 2.3% of the US domestic cider market.

HOW HARVEST DRIVEN CIDER IS SOLD



Almost all, 98%, of harvest driven cider producers are selling their ciders in bottles.


75% of producers sell their harvest driven ciders on draft in tasting rooms and tap rooms.





Only 18% of harvest driven cider producers are canning their ciders for sale.

WHERE HARVEST DRIVEN CIDER IS SOLD



58% of harvest driven ciders are sold direct to consumers.

32% of harvest driven ciders are sold for onsite consumption by consumers.





21% of harvest driven ciders are sold onsite for consumers to take to-go.

5% of harvest driven cider sales occur through online sales channels.



APPLES USED FOR HARVEST DRIVEN CIDER



60% of harvest driven ciders are made using tannic or heirloom apples that cost more than \$15 per bushel.

48% of harvest driven ciders are produced with some or all of the fruit being grown by the harvest driven cider producers.



CIDER CLUBS



53% of harvest driven cider producers have cider clubs.

These cider clubs currently have more than 5600 members.
